BSN Admissions Checklist for Potential AMEDD/AECP Students

Please note that all applicants, including direct admits and AMEDD/AECP, must submit BOTH an application to <u>APSU</u> and an application to the <u>BSN program</u>. These are two separate applications and BOTH must be completed in order to be considered for admission to the pre-licensure BSN program.

Please note that AMEDD/AECP cannot be utilized with APSU's RN-BSN program as the program is 100% online.

<u>The Austin Peay Center at Fort Campbell</u> (please email <u>APFortCampbellCenter@apsu.edu</u>) advisors will assist with understanding military benefits, applying to APSU (free for uniformed personnel), the Tuition Assistance (TA) Memo (if needed), and ensuring transcripts have transferred into the University (Degree Works tracking system) correctly and requesting substitutions for classes that did not transfer in automatically.
