

## **What is a Monitored Student and Why Alert Them?**

Instructors of 1000 and 2000 level courses are requested each semester to submit Academic Alerts for those students designated on the Academic Alert Roster as ***monitored***. Who are these students and why are we interested in knowing how they are doing?

Monitored students are those who are at most risk of not being successful in their studies. They come to the University with deficiencies in their academic preparation or may be returning students who have not done well in past attempts at Austin Peay. The University also monitors groups of special interest. Monitored student currently include conditionally admitted students, students returning from suspension (PASS), students readmitted by committee, and Middle College students.

Monitored students appear at the top of the Academic Alert roster and have **Monitored** in bold letters following each student's name. All other students are listed as "**Optional**" and although no alert is requested for these students, we do encourage instructors to submit alerts if there are concerns.
