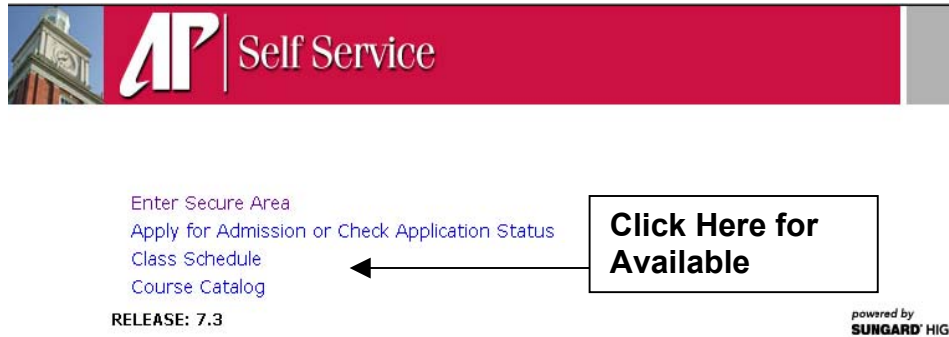


Search for Classes through AP Self Service
