

## The Wyatt Award

The Wyatt Award, sponsored by the Office of Alumni Affairs, is a trophy that is awarded annually to the student organization that, through participation in Homecoming, demonstrates the greatest amount of school spirit.

To be considered “in attendance” for any given event, at least five organization members must be present and signed in. There will be a sign-in table at every Homecoming event for this purpose. To participate in an event, the organization must have a completed entry form for the event at the published deadline *and be present* to do what they signed up to do. If an organization wins an event, it will have the listed amount of points added to its score. The total number of points an organization can get (assuming it attends and participates in all events and wins all contests) is 215. The organization that comes closest to this number will win the Wyatt Award.

The winner of the Wyatt Award will be announced at the Homecoming football game and will receive both the trophy and a \$300 award. The organization with the second largest number of points will receive \$200, and the organization that has accumulated the least number of points will receive \$100.

The Gops Organization Council (GOC) will be responsible for tallying all points and determining the award winner.
