The Cabinet met on January 5 at 9:00 a.m. Present were: Bryant, Byrd, Chin, Clark, Denley, Drew, Gregory, Hall, Jackson, McQueen, Mulkeen, Persinger, Robinson, Struckmeyer and Lori Buchanan (Faculty Senate Rep)

- Hall recapped some of APSU's successes for 2008. These included:
 - Implemented the Middle College
 - Hemlock Semiconductor business and new program
 - Ability to respond to budget cuts without cuts in instruction or personnel due to careful stewardship of APSU's resources
 - Received 16.5% increase in external funding over 2006-07 year
 - Increased in enrollment and retention
 - Increased 20% in philanthropic donations
 - Implemented the Governors School of Computational Physics
- Hall presented budget briefing.
- Hall distributed a handout of what he sees as the priorities for APSU in 2009.
- Hall asked the Cabinet to review the strategic goals discussed at a previous meeting to determine if progress is being made to accomplish them in a timely manner.
- Hall asked Mulkeen to lead the discussion on performance funding and how it affects APSU at the next Cabinet's meeting
