Unclassified Admission

Applicants who are in the process of completing their application for admission may be admitted on an unclassified status, which allows them to take up to nine hours of graduate coursework. Applicants must submit all documentation by the end of their first nine graduate semester hours. Students in the School of Education *must* submit a transcript showing a cumulative undergraduate GPA of at least 2.75 before receiving Unclassified Admission.

Regular Admission

To be admitted, an applicant must have a bachelor's degree with a minimum cumulative undergraduate GPA of 2.75, and meet the conditions of BOTH of the following formulae:

$$\text{GPA} \times 100 + \text{GRE}(\text{verbal}) > 600$$

$$\text{GPA} \times 100 + \text{GRE}(\text{quantitative}) > 600$$

OR a student must score at least 383 on the Millers Analogy Test in addition to having a bachelor's degree with a 2.75 cumulative undergraduate GPA.

Conditional Admission

An applicant *may* be granted conditional admission status if he/she does not meet the criteria for regular admission. In consultation with the department, the Dean of the College of Graduate Studies may grant conditional admission to a student. This decision is generally based on the cumulative GPA in undergraduate coursework, the GPA in either the last two years or the upper-division credits of the bachelor's degree and the total of the scores attained on the verbal and quantitative sections of the GRE. Students admitted conditionally must maintain a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0 during the first 12 graduate semester hours completed at APSU. Failure to maintain a 3.0 cumulative GPA during the first 12 semester hours of graduate coursework results in suspension from the graduate program.

Denied Status

Applicants who do not meet the regular or conditional criteria for admission will be denied admission to the program.

Program of Study

Within the first nine credit hours, you must initiate a program of study by contacting your advisor or your department secretary. Education students are especially urged to do this as early as possible.
