

## APSU Math Courses Suitable for Dual/Joint-Enrolled Students

Math 2110	Math 1920 OR Advanced Placement Calculus BC score of 4	Business, Liberal Arts, Social Sciences, Nursing (APSU), Physical Sciences, Biology, Mathematics, Engineering, Pre-professional programs such as pre-med, dentistry, etc.
Math 1810	Algebra I, Algebra II, Geometry, Precalculus.  In addition, student must present ACT-M subscore of 25 OR acceptable APSU placement test score	Business, Liberal Arts, Nursing

High school counselors may contact the APSU Mathematics Department Chair to make arrangements for administration of the on-line APSU mathematics placement test. There may be a nominal fee for the placement test.
