Courses and Schedules

Class schedules and course descriptions are available at AP Self Service which is found via the Quick Links on the APSU home page at <http://www.apsu.edu/>. You will be asked to select a term (i.e., spring II 2010 – FC) from the drop down box which will take you to a screen where you can select courses by subject. If the term you are looking for is not in the drop down list, those schedules are not yet available for viewing.

Tuition and Fees

Current tuition at the Fort Campbell Center is \$202.25 per credit-hour for face-to-face classes. A fee of \$23 per credit-hour is added for online courses for a total of \$225.25 per credit-hour. Complete details on all fees are available at <http://www.apsu.edu/businessoffice/acctrec/>.

Tennessee Dual Lottery Scholarship

All dual and joint students are eligible for the Tennessee Dual Lottery Scholarship, which currently provides \$100 per semester credit – up to \$300 per term or \$600 per academic year. This application should be completed online for *only* the current semester of enrollment and must be submitted again for each subsequent semester (deadlines are firm): <https://egrands.guarantorsolutions.com/scholarshipapps/>.

Students must maintain a minimum GPA of 2.75 in their college credits to receive the Dual Lottery Scholarship in subsequent semesters. If their college GPA falls below 2.75, they will not be eligible for dual enrollment lottery funds in the future. This will not affect their eligibility for Hope Scholarship funds once they graduate from high school.

Other Financial Aid

Currently, APSU has limited resources to assist students with tuition and fees beyond the \$300 Dual Lottery Scholarship. We continue to work on obtaining additional funding, but for now, the following resources are available:

1. APSU has a need-based Dual Enrollment Scholarship with limited funding; that application can be found at www.apsu.edu/GoSooner.
2. For students meeting certain economic eligibility guidelines, there may be some funding available from the Workforce Investment Act (WIA). If you would like further information, please contact us.
