

ACADEMIC COUNCIL MINUTES
March 26, 2010

1. Academic Council approved a change in definition of conditional admit students **from** deficiency in mathematics and writing **to** at least two deficiencies from mathematics, reading and writing.

2. Approval was also given for the following list of departments making minor revisions to the sociology major, concentrations and specialization with one new minor to be offered at Fort Campbell in Professional Studies (B.P.S).

Dept. of Music - revised minor in music for B.A. and B.S.

Dept. of Sociology- a new course was added to their electives at upper division level.

Dept. of Management, Marketing, General Business- added three existing courses as choices in the elective portion of Marketing requirements(MKT 3610, 3620 and 4100).

Dept. of Teaching and Learning -added a new concentration entitled Interdisciplinary Studies in Early Childhood. The Department also revised the specialization in M.A. in Instructional Media to meet changing standards of practice.

Dept. of Professional Studies - New minor in Professional Studies at Ft. Campbell (B.P.S.).

Dept.of Public Management and Criminal Justice - revised the minor in Criminal Justice with concentration in Homeland Security
