

So you think you can be a Sigma Rho Chi?

Before you begin filling out the Sigma Rho Chi Application form there are a few things you need to be aware of.

- 1) Being a Sigma Rho Chi counselor is very important it is not just an excuse to get out of doing recruitment with your own Sorority. You will be doing just as much work as you would with your own Sorority, if not more. There will be late nights and lots of hard work all the same.

- 2) You will be asked to disaffiliate from your own organization the day after graduation until Bid Day 2010, this will mean the following:
 - a. You are not allowed to wear/carry any type of insignia, have anything on your facebook insinuating what organization you belong to, have any car decals or stickers supporting your organization, talk to active sorority women or alumna, or attend your organizations meetings.
 - b. You will be asked to attend all meetings/events that are mandatory and all Sigma Rho Chi retreats, which are planned for the following:
 - i. Spring 2010 (Mandatory)
 - ii. Summer 2010 (Mandatory)
 - iii. Fall 2010 (Mandatory)
 - c. You must support the Panhellenic Council by promoting sorority recruitment during Summer Welcomes.
 - d. You are not allowed to discuss any recruitment information with anyone other than (2010) Sigma Rho Chi's or the Greek Advisor (Brianna Lombardozzi).
 - e. You must have a GPA of at least or above a 2.5

**Failure to adhere to these guidelines will either result in your termination or a fine filed against you.

- 3) Being a Sigma Rho Chi, means being a counselor, not a cop to report infractions done by another organization. If the problem is serious it will be dealt with. However, your job is to counsel the potential new member's, make them feel welcomed, comfortable and most importantly to help them have a great time through recruitment week. Everyone can be placed in a sorority; it is your job to help them make the best choice.

- 4) Being a Sigma Rho Chi will be one of the most rewarding experiences. You will make new friends, help others find a sorority that fits them, gain valuable traits that will last a lifetime and make many memories to last a lifetime.
