Program Overview

Through this program, you will take part in an intensive German language program at the Language Institute of the Universität Klagenfurt. You will reside at Wörther Lake in the Alps, just a 10-minute walk from the university. In your leisure time, you'll get a taste of Austrian culture – including real strudel and schnitzel – during activities such as day trips, cultural events, sports activities and a three-day visit to Vienna. You must have basic knowledge of German or instructor permission.

You will register for APSU's GERM 3040: Study Abroad in German, choosing from studies in beginning German¹, intermediate German², advanced German³, literature³ and Austrian Culture³.

We will travel from Vienna to Klagenfurt and then back to Vienna. If you wish to travel with a group of students, you will fly out of – and into – Nashville International Airport (BNA).

Lodging and Meals

You'll reside in a double occupancy room in a modern dormitory with cooking facility. Single rooms cost more and are available upon request. You'll receive a meal stipend each week.
