Payment Schedule and Deadlines

- Apply for the fall semester by Feb. 1. Apply for the spring semester by Sept. 1.
- A non-refundable application fee of \$200 is due when you apply.
- If you are accepted to begin study in the fall, your admission and housing applications are due to Klagenfurt by mid-May. For study in the spring, paperwork is due to Klagenfurt University by mid-October.
- An Austrian student visa is required to participate in the program.

Financial aid is available. Your current scholarships and financial aid may apply toward the cost of the program.
