Exchange Program • Spring or Fall • Semester or Academic Year

Program Overview

You can study French for one or two semesters at the Université d'Orléans in the city of Joan of Arc, located about one hour south of Paris. You will attend classes for approximately 20 hours per week and take part in optional afternoon activities like singing and theater. Some previous knowledge of French is required (FREN 2020 or equivalent).

Credit-Hours

12-18 credit-hours per semester

Courses

Register for FREN 3050: Semester Study in France. Classes offered at Université d'Orléans include French composition, grammar, speaking, phonetics, listening comprehension and cinema.

Lodging and Meals

You will stay in a single room in a dormitory located on campus or close to public transportation. Meals are available in the student cafeterias.

Prices are subject to change due to increases in airfare, fluctuation of currency exchange and changes in tuition and fee rates. Estimated cost may not include airfare, APSU tuition, or health coverage unless specified. You also should budget funds for personal expenses based upon your spending habits.

Financial aid is available. The program provides a \$100 scholarship for each semester you participate. You will receive this sum shortly after the beginning of each semester. Your current scholarships and financial aid may apply toward the cost of the program. Additional scholarships and travel grants are available through the Office of International Education.

Payment Schedule and Deadlines

- Apply for the fall semester by Feb. 1. Apply for the spring semester by Sept. 1.
- A non-refundable application fee of \$200 is due when you apply.
- If you are accepted to begin study in the fall, your admission and housing applications are due to the Université d'Orléans by mid-May. For study in the spring, paperwork is due to Université d'Orléans by mid-October.
- Register for FREN 3050 during APSU class registration for the semester in which you will study abroad.
- A French student visa is required for this program.
