## Lodging and Meals

You will reside in a double-occupancy room in a dormitory housing both Korean and international students. You must supply your own blanket, pillow, towels and slippers. Three meals per day are provided in the dormitory cafeteria.

Prices are subject to change due to increases in airfare, fluctuation of currency exchange and changes in tuition and fee rates. Estimated cost may not include airfare, APSU tuition or health coverage unless specified. You also should budget funds for personal expenses based upon your spending habits.

**Financial aid** is available. You can apply for a KNU fellowship scholarship which covers housing and meal plan fees of about \$1,000 per semester. Your current scholarships and financial aid may apply toward the cost of the program. Call the Office of Student Financial Aid at (931) 221-7907 to schedule an appointment with a financial aid counselor. Additional scholarships and travel grants are available through the Office of International Education.

## Payment Schedule and Deadlines

- Apply and submit supporting documents by May 25 for fall program or by Nov. 25 for spring program.
- KNU tuition, roughly \$1,900, must be paid by the beginning of the semester.
