**Austin Peay State University Retirees Association  
(APSURA)**

The meeting of the APSURA held at 1:00 p.m. on July 22, 2009 in the President's Conference Room was called to order by Al Bekus. Present were: Al Bekus, Ann Harris, Aleeta Christian, Gerald Beavers, Wayne Chaffin and Hester Crews.

Ann Harris moved that the minutes of the July 16 meeting be accepted as submitted. The motion was seconded by Al Bekus and was unanimously approved.

Wayne Chaffin presented the Treasurer's report:

No outstanding bills

16 completed Member Registration Forms

Ann Harris moved to accept the report as submitted; Aleeta Christian seconded the motion. The motion was unanimously approved.

There was discussion concerning APSURA's participation in the August 26 convocation activities. Al announced President Hall agrees participation of the group is an excellent idea and will check on available space at convocation and the reception to follow. Al will check with Andy Kean for reservation of a room for the first general APSURA meeting following the reception.

Al announced he will be out of town July 24 – August 4. In his absence, Gerald will follow through with completion of the Newsletter to include information concerning August 26. Gerald will get the Newsletter to Bill Persinger. It was agreed the Member Registration Form will be included in each Newsletter and the date for return of the Form will be August 15.

Cost for mailing the Newsletter was discussed. According to Roy Gregory, if no return envelope is included his office will pay all costs. If an envelope is included, the \$99 previously approved will be applied. Gerald moved that APSURA accept the offer by Roy Gregory and allow his office to fund the entire cost of this mailing and not include a return envelope. The motion was seconded by Al Bekus and unanimously approved. It was agreed the labels for the mailing list will be the same as those used for the reception invitation, with the addition of department chairs. It was agreed information concerning upcoming Homecoming activities will be included in the Newsletter.

Gerald reported Media Services estimates the cost of printing at \$131 with color included on the front page and \$41 if no color. Al moved that APSURA pay the cost of printing estimated at \$141 with color on the front page; Gerald seconded the motion. The motion was unanimously approved.

Hester, Ann and Aleeta agreed to call those retirees who have completed a Member Form the week before the August 26 convocation activities to remind and encourage them to attend. Hester will divide the list and get contact information to Ann and Aleeta by Monday, August 17.

Al announced President Hall was very complimentary of the work the APSURA is doing. The President indicated he would like to see the citizens of the University and community coming together through cultural activities.

At 2:00 p.m. Aleeta moved for adjournment, seconded by Ann and unanimously approved.
