Gerald Beavers moved that the minutes of the May 1 meeting be accepted as submitted. The motion was seconded by Aleeta Christian and approved unanimously.

The first item of business was to revisit the dues as established at the May 1 meeting. There was concern that the \$50 might be prohibitive for some members for a new organization with goals/objectives/activities yet to be established. Following much discussion it was moved by Ann Harris and seconded by Gerald Beavers that:

Donation amounts be \$5, \$10, \$15, \$20, \$25 and "other", and  
Dues be assessed beginning July 1, 2010.

The motion was unanimously approved. It was agreed that the membership registration form will be included in a membership newsletter.

The next item of business was a membership reception/brunch. Following discussion, it was recommended a brunch be held on Monday, June 22, from 11 a.m. to 1 p.m. at Emerald Hills Alumni Center. Annelle Gracey and Al Bekus agreed to work with Development and Alumni to finalize date, location, time, menu and the mailing of invitations/RSVP's.

Gerald Beavers will present ideas for the membership form at the next meeting and will be working on the APSURA's web site with Steve Wilson. Gerald announced the APSU mailing address for the group is: PO Box 4426, APSU; Clarksville, TN 37044.

Al Bekus will call the next meeting.

Motion to adjourn was made by Al Bekus, seconded by Ann Harris and approved unanimously. The meeting was adjourned at 2:20 p.m.
