FAFSA Terminology

- Expected Family Contribution (EFC) is now Student Aid Index (SAI)
- Household Size is now Family Size
- Student, Parents, Guardians, Spouse are Contributors
- Consent to provide financial information is required



FAFSA Terminology

- Dependency status is now student personal circumstances
- Special circumstances and student unusual circumstances
- IRS Data Retrieval Tool (DRT) is now Direct Data Exchange (DDX)
- Federal Tax Information (FTI)
- Student Aid Report (SAR) is now FAFSA Submission Summary (FSS)



Formula: From EFC to SAI

Q: How is my Student Aid Index (SAI)(formerly my EFC) calculated?

A: Most of the questions on your application will be used to calculate your SAI which is a measurement of your financial aid eligibility based on your family's tax and asset information.

Q: How do I find out my SAI and how will it be used?

A: It will be listed on your FAFSA Submission Summary. It will be used to help prepare you financial aid offer and to assist you financial need using this formula:

Cost of Attendance (COA) – SAI – Other Financial Assistance = Financial Need



Changes to the FAFSA

Q: Will the FAFSA questions be the same?

A: Several Questions have been changes or removed, including: CHANGED:

- Number of people in college in your household
- Pell Grant eligibility calculation

REMOVED:

- Housing plan choice
- Selective Service registration
- Drug conviction reporting



Preparing to Apply: Federal Student Aid ID

- For the 2024-2025 application, all contributors (student, student's spouse, student's parent/s or guardian/s) are required to have a Federal Student Aid ID (FSA ID):
 - To access FAFSA
 - To retrieve tax information using the IRS Direct Data Exchange (DDX), if applicable
 - To sign the FAFSA electronically
- Create your FSA ID now, prior to the FAFSA opening in December 2023
 - There will be a 1-3 day confirmation period before you can use it
 - Forgotten FAS IDs can be retrieved



Preparing to Apply: Documents

- Student's 2022 federal income tax return, or evidence of income earned (W-2 form or pay records)
- Contributors' federal income tax return from tax return from tax year
 2022
- Records of child support received
- Current balances of cash, savings, and checking accounts
- Net worth of investments, businesses, and farms




Preparing to Apply: Federal Student Aid ID

- File the FAFSA as soon as possible, starting in December 2023
 - FAFSA: <u>https://studentaid.gov/</u>
- Fill out the APSU Scholarship Application before February 1, 2024
 - APSU Scholarship Application: <u>https://www.apsu.edu/scholarships/</u>
- If you are a Tennessee Promise recipient, apply by April 15, 2024
 - Tennessee Promise application: <u>https://www.tn.gov/tnpromise</u>




Contributors will receive an email asking them to log in and complete their portion of the application.
