

Physical Education Program for Home-Schooled Children

The Department of Health & Human Performance at Austin Peay State University is offering a six-week (Wednesdays only, except last date is Monday, Nov. 9 as Veteran's Day is observed Nov. 11) physical education program for home-schooled children. Children ages 4 – 14 are invited to attend physical education classes taught by APSU students who are seeking health and physical education licensure. The dates are October 7, 14, 21, 28, November 4, and Monday the 9th. The cost is \$10.00 per child and \$5.00 per sibling for the six week program. Children are divided into four age groups allowing four concurrent teaching stations each Wednesday.
