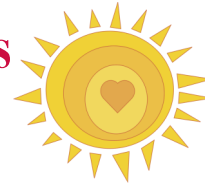

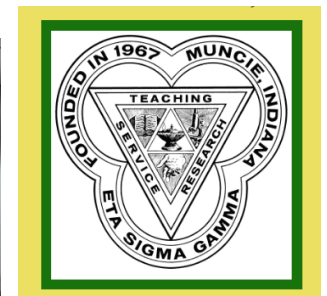

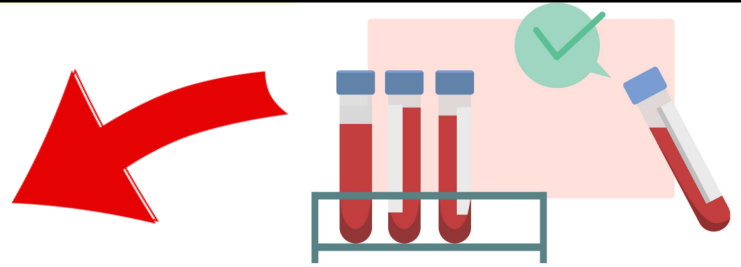
# Making a Difference in the Community
