### Content/Composition (50%)

#### 1. Originality/Related to Subject.

- Does the speech seem to reflect the speaker's own convictions?
- Does the speech give evidence of original and creative thinking by the speaker?
- Does the speech deal with the subject?

#### 2. Organization/Logical Sequence

- Is the content arranged in such a way that the audience has no difficulty in following the speech?
- Is the speech designed to develop the content to a climax in an orderly way?

#### 3. Structure/Grammar

- Does the speaker use complete sentences, and are the sentences grammatically correct?

#### 4. Choice of resources/Credit for Quotations

- If resources are used, do they reflect an adequate understanding of the various facets of the subject and are these used in a way that they add strength to the content of the speech?
- Does the delivered speech indicate that the material used is being quoted?

#### 5. Purpose Accomplished

- Does the body of the speech do what it is intended to do as evidenced by the subject and content?

### Delivery (50%)

#### 1. Delivered without notes

- Does the speaker give speech without notes?
- Does the speaker use or rely on note ?
- Does the speaker have to be prompted?

#### 2. Articulate/Expressive Communication

- Does the speaker speak distinctly and clearly?
- Does the speaker speak without stammering and grasping for words.
- Is the speech sincere, pleasing, convincing, interesting, and understandable?

#### 3. Poise/Confidence

- Does the speaker appear to be composed and at ease?
- Does the speaker appear to believe in himself and his message?

#### 4. Posture/Personal Appearance

- Does the speaker stand up straight
- Is the speaker well-groomed, and is his clothing in good taste?

#### 5. Within Time Allotment

- Does the speaker stay within the four-to-six minute allotment?
- Remember-speeches shorter or longer will be penalized at two points for each ten seconds over or under the allotted time.
