All administrative aspects of the University are organized under the President who is directly responsible to the Tennessee Board of Regents. The following officers are directly responsible to the President:

- Director of Athletics
- Director of Grants
- Director of Internal Audit
- Director of Institute for Global Security Studies
- Executive Assistant to the President
- Executive Director of Public Relations and Marketing
- Executive Director of University Advancement
- Provost and Vice President for Academic and Student Affairs
- Vice President for Finance and Administration
- Vice President for Legal Affairs and Strategic Planning

In addition, certain standing committees, Council, and the Faculty Senate serve in an advisory role to the President. The accompanying chart depicts the organizational structure for University Administration.

Departments or divisions under these positions have a department head or chairperson, a supervisor, dean, or a director, who is responsible for the immediate operations of the department, or other area of responsibility.
