The academic and student aspects of the University are organized under the Provost and Vice President for Academic and Student Affairs, who is responsible directly to the President of the University. The following officers are responsible to the Provost and Vice President for Academic and Student Affairs.

- Assistant Vice President for Academic Affairs
- Associate Vice President for Student Affairs
- Dean, College of Arts and Letters
- Dean, College of Graduate Studies
- Dean, College of Professional Programs and Social Sciences
- Dean, Enrollment Management & Academic Support
- Dean, College of Science and Mathematics
- Dean, Extended and Distance Education
- Director, Library
- Executive Director, School of Technology and Public Management

Departments or units under the above offices have a department chairperson, coordinator or director who is responsible for the immediate operations of the department or unit.

Academic, curricular and budgetary affairs associated with the principal offices and their departments or units all come under the general supervision of the Provost and Vice President for Academic and Student Affairs.
