

Kids and Chemistry Activity Form

The safety of our APSU students and audience should be number one in our minds. The XEM advisor should also know what activities XEM students are presenting inside and outside the APSU campus. To that end we will use the following guidelines for student groups doing activities or making presentations not under direct supervision of department faculty:

1. All student groups making a presentation not under the direct supervision of faculty must file a K&C form with Dr. Brennan in advance of the activity or presentation showing what activities will be performed or material will be presented. These activities must be approved by a department faculty (faculty signature on the form). For demonstrations this approval should involve making sure that the group understands all safety precautions to be used with the activities.
2. No student group will be allowed to take liquid nitrogen, concentrated acids or bases, or other hazardous material out of the department without an accompanying department faculty member. (Other hazardous material will be determined by the approving faculty member.)
3. Safety goggles must be worn at all times by APSU students.
4. An activity certification form must be filed with Dr. Brennan after the activity.
