PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE, Joe Schiller

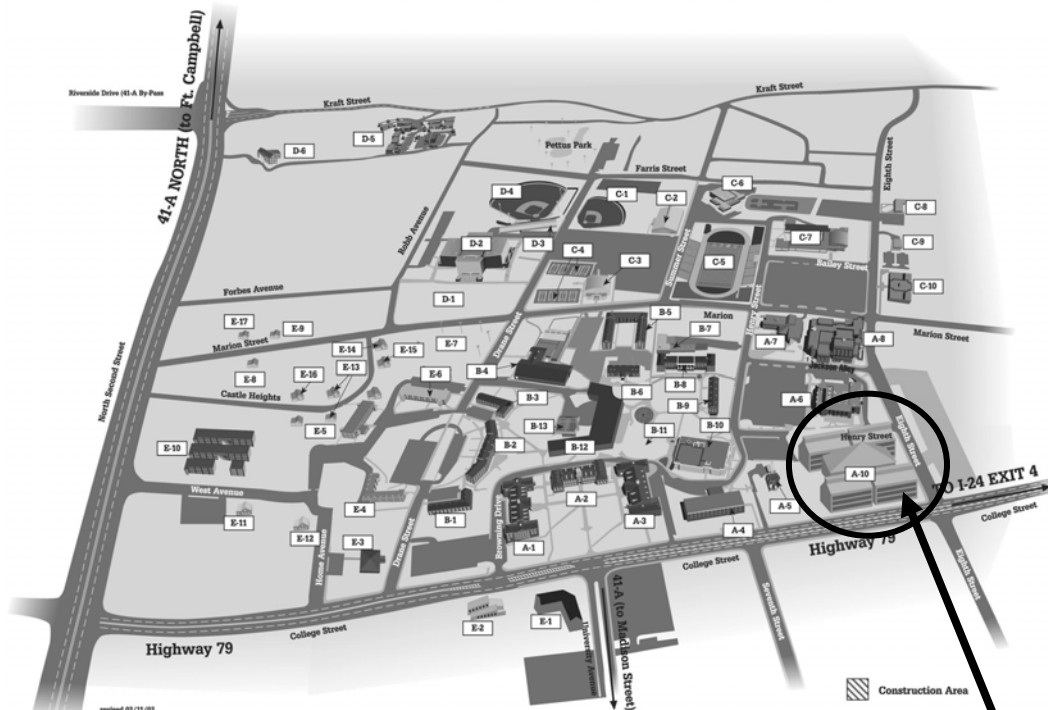
