<p><b>Section V.</b> Nominations and Elections Committee</p> <p>The Nominations and Elections Committee shall consist of at least five (5) Senators. The committee shall make, subject to approval of the Senate, nominations and conduct elections which are requested by persons or groups outside the Senate.
