

# English as a Second Language (ESL) Institute

## Interested in applying for APSU campus housing?

Limited housing in campus residence halls is available for full-time ESL students. A separate on-line housing application and a room reservation deposit of U.S. \$200 (payable online) are required once accepted into the ESL Institute. This deposit is applied to the cost of rent.

**Interested students should contact the ESL Institute at the time of application to the ESL Institute for more details and assistance on applying for campus housing.**

**All housing is assigned on a first-come/first-serve basis, so apply for housing early!** Campus housing generally is full about a month before classes start, so please apply BEFORE arriving on campus.

All students living in University housing should provide their own bed linens, towels and other personal accessories, and are responsible for care and cleaning of the room.

***Before you start the Housing application process, please carefully read the following information.***

Austin Peay State University offers many different options for living on campus. All halls and apartments are designated as smoke-free. To see descriptions, residency requirements and floor plans for all options, go to <http://www.apsu.edu/Housing/rates.aspx>.

Most options are for double occupancy (two people per room), with single occupancy possible only if space is available, and for a higher cost. Costs quoted (see back of page) are per semester (unless otherwise indicated) and are subject to change.

- Freshmen Residence Halls are designated for 1<sup>st</sup> year students. (*Most ESL Institute students will be considered 1<sup>st</sup> year students.*)
- Sophomore and Above residences are for 2<sup>nd</sup> year or sophomore and above students only.
- Honors Halls require all residents to have an ACT of 21+ as new freshman, or a cumulative GPA of 3.0, for current returning residents. You must maintain at least a 3.0 cumulative GPA while living in the hall.
- Co-educational: Both male and female students may live in the same building, but will not live in the same room nor will they have shared bathrooms facilities.

# APSU Residence Halls and University Apartments

## Freshmen Residence Halls

- **Blount Hall** ~ Double Occupancy \$2200 per semester  
A co-educational freshmen hall with male students on the first floor; female students on the second and third floor.
- **Harvill Hall** ~ Double Occupancy \$2200 per semester  
A co-educational honors hall by invitation only.
- **Sevier Hall** ~ Double Occupancy \$2200 per semester  
An all-women's residence.
- **Castle Heights** ~ Double Occupancy \$2900 per semester  
A co-educational residence.

## Sophomore and Above Residence Halls

- **Miller Hall** ~ Private \$2950 per semester  
An all men's residence with single occupancy rooms.

## Sophomore and Above Apartments

- **Emerald Hill** ~ One Bedroom \$590 per month  
Family and non-traditional student housing with one bedroom apartments for single students 23 years of age and above, as well as graduate students. Two and three bedroom apartments are also available for families.
- **Hand Village** ~ Private \$3190 per semester  
Suite style living where each apartment has four single bedrooms and two shared bathrooms.
- **Meacham Apartments** ~ Double Occupancy \$2185 per semester  
A co-educational residence for honor students.
- **Marion St. Apartments** ~ Double Occupancy \$2185 per semester  
A co-educational apartment complex.
- **Two Rivers Apartments** ~ Double Occupancy \$2300 per semester  
A co-educational residence.
