

The APSU GoSooner Dual Enrollment Award

Begin college now with dual enrollment at Austin Peay and reduce your costs with the APSU GoSooner Award!

WHO: Eligible APSU dual and joint enrollment students. Go to www.apsu.edu/gosooner for details on admission requirements.

WHAT: You will receive \$100 per credit-hour for up to six credit-hours for a maximum award of \$600 per semester. The award will apply after the Tennessee Dual Enrollment Lottery Grant and any employee discounts are applied to your student account.

For example (based on 2011-2012 tuition and fees):

\$278.20 per credit-hour (main campus course)	
One three credit-hour course	\$834.60

**Additional fees may apply depending on the particular course, and the award does not cover the cost of textbooks and other required materials.*

*** Additional TN lottery grant award will reduce the student's HOPE Scholarship after high school.*

The award may be renewed through high school graduation, provided you continue to meet the eligibility requirements (2.75 GPA in your college courses). The continuance of the program is also based on the availability of funding.

HOW: You will automatically receive the award if you do the following:

- Apply – and are accepted – for dual or joint enrollment at APSU
- Register for classes
- Apply for the Tennessee Dual Enrollment Lottery Grant
- Any discounts for which you are eligible (parents who are employees of the state, public school system or APSU/TBR) will be applied to your account before the GoSooner award.
- Maintain a GPA of 2.75 in your college courses
