

## Grants & Scholarship Opportunities for Dual Enrollment Students

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### Tennessee Dual Lottery Grant (DEG)

- Complete online application at <https://egrands.guarantorsolutions.com/scholarshipapps/>.
- If you will be taking your fifth or more dual enrollment course, sign the *Additional Courses Acknowledgement* electronically at the same time you apply for the grant.
- Complete APSU's *Additional Courses and Funding Agreement* on this form and **submit to the Extended Education office**.
- If you are not eligible for the DEG due to residency requirements, please notify the Extended Education office.
- You must maintain a 2.75 GPA in college classes to receive the DEG in subsequent semesters.

### APSU GoSooner Award

- **Notify the Extended Education office** if you are eligible for a tuition discount or waiver by completing the form on the reverse side of this page; attach your completed discount form (see next step).
- Submit the appropriate discount form **to the Extended Education office before you register for class**. Specific forms and further details are available at <http://www.apsu.edu/bursar/discounts>.
- The GoSooner award will not be applied to the student's account until the appropriate discount form is submitted to the Extended Education office.
- The Tennessee Dual Enrollment Lottery Grant application also serves as the application for the GoSooner Award.

### APSU Dual Enrollment Scholarship (need-based)

- Check to make sure all three pages are completed, including all signatures. Incomplete applications will NOT be accepted.

This will allow us to assist you in tracking your progress through admissions, registrations and payment.

Dual Enrollment Grant Additional Courses and Funding Agreement

In addition to the Additional Courses Acknowledgement you signed electronically when applying for the Tennessee Dual Enrollment Grant (DEG), please note your preferred option below.

High school juniors and seniors may take four (4) dual enrollment courses without affecting their Hope Scholarship funding. For additional DEG funding beyond five (5) courses, the student must qualify for the HOPE Scholarship and provide appropriate documentation. The HOPE Scholarship requires a high school GPA of 3.0 or an ACT score of 21. (TN home school students must meet ACT requirements and have been enrolled in a home school program for two years immediately preceding graduation.) The same standards must be maintained in subsequent semesters.

- I understand the information contained in this Additional Courses and Funding Agreement. I authorize Austin Peay State University to use my dual enrollment funding provided by TSAC for two courses totaling up to \$600 (\$100 per credit hour) per semester.
I elect NOT to receive the additional Dual Enrollment Grant funding after four courses in order to prevent my HOPE Scholarship monies from being reduced during my freshman year of college.
I have not yet taken five or more dual enrollment courses.
I am registered for another dual enrollment course at another institution. (Name of institution)
