

“At least three (3) years of full-time faculty status at Austin Peay State University at the rank of Assistant Professor shall be required for promotion to Associate Professor. Any exceptions to this requirement will need the written approval of the President.” (p. 4 of 6, 5:061)

At least five (5) years of faculty status at the rank of Associate Professor at Austin Peay State University shall be the normal expectation for promotion to Full Professor. Any exceptions to this requirement will require the written approval of the President.

Example: Faculty begins employment Fall 09 as Asst. Professor. No years have been awarded toward tenure.
