

Global Learning Travel Grant

The Office of International Education at Austin Peay State University prepares students to be educated about the world, experienced with intercultural communication and equipped with an international skill set necessary to support future community needs in an increasingly international society. The Global Learning Scholarship funds provide greater access to study-abroad and exchange program opportunities by providing the Travel Grant for students participating in APSU-sponsored study-abroad and exchange programs.

Award: The Global Learning Travel Grant awards are based on the budget, number of expected study-abroad participants and the number of study-abroad and exchange programs expected during the academic year.

Application deadline:

- Applicants for winter 2011-2012 short-term study-abroad programs and spring 2012 exchange programs must apply by Oct. 13, 2011.
- Applicants for summer 2012 short-term study abroad and fall 2012 exchange programs must apply by March 1, 2012.

Eligibility requirements:

- The scholarship is open to full-time main campus students who have paid the program service fee for either the spring semester or fall semester preceding the study-abroad or exchange program. Part-time main-campus students who have paid the program service fee are eligible at a pro-rated amount.
- Applicants must have successfully completed at least one semester of full-time studies at APSU, have a record of enrollment and a minimum G.P.A. of 2.25 on file.
- Applicants must have no history of student code of conduct violations.
- Applicants must not currently be on academic probation or suspension.

Application process:

1. Complete and submit the Study-Abroad Application Form 2012.
2. Complete an application for the Global Learning Travel Grant (page 2). **Please send no additional information other than what is asked for on the form.**
3. Send the application postmarked by deadline date to the following address below or drop off at Harned Hall, Room 127.
4. Late applications will not be considered for awards. Notifications of awards will be sent to recipients by official campus e-mail no later than 30 days after fall or spring deadline.
