**JOIN APSU FRIENDS ON A TRIP TO GREECE!**

Our APSU Retirees Association is promoting the Alumni Association's 2011 summer trip to Greece, July 16-26. At a recent meeting, Dr. Tim Winters, Professor of Classical Languages in the Language and Literature Department and leader of this trip, showed slides, and new Alumni Director Nikki Loos Peterson handed out the itinerary and cost information. In brief, the group will visit Athens, Mykonos, Patmos/Rhodes, Heraklion/Santorini, Piraeus, Corinth, Epidaurus, Nafplion, and Delphi. Participants will be staying in top of the line hotels as well as enjoying a four-day Mediterranean cruise. Basic cost is \$3,095 per person. This price will be reduced if 15 or more commit. Air fare from Atlanta will be an addition, approximately \$1,688.60. A \$300 deposit is due December 1.

Tim has been taking students to Greece since 1981 and is, of course, fluent in Greek. He is so familiar with every aspect of this area that this trip is truly a dream vacation.
