

Mid-Tennessee Collaborative MSW Program Application

To the Applicant:

Thank you for your interest in this MSW program. This is one program that has three locations: Austin Peay State University, Middle Tennessee State University, and Tennessee State University. You will be asked to select your home campus. This is the location where you will register, pay tuition and fees, attend in-person classes, and receive your degree. Online classes may be taught by professors from your home campus or from the other two sites. Through your in-person classes, you will get to know your home campus cohort; through your online classes, you will become acquainted with those students who are in your same program, just at a different locale.

You must meet the following requirements to be eligible for regular program admission:

1. Graduation from an accredited college or university, with a bachelor's degree which includes coursework in the area of liberal arts
2. A cumulative GPA of 2.75 or higher
3. Completion of the Graduate Record Exam

You must meet the following requirements to be eligible for advanced standing admission:

1. Graduation from an accredited college or university, with a bachelor's degree in social work which is accredited by the Council on Social Work Education. There is no time limit on when the degree was received.
2. A cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher.
3. Completion of the Graduate Record Exam.

Enrollment is limited.

Applications will be accepted as of October 1, 2011. Review of complete applications, which includes all required supporting documentation, begins March 1, 2012. Once available admission slots are filled, additional applications will not be accepted.

All application materials should be submitted as early as possible.

The application process for this MSW program requires two steps:

- (1) **Apply to the Graduate College of your home campus.** This application is completed online. Your transcripts and your GRE scores must be sent to the Graduate College. You can access your home campus Graduate College at:

2. Briefly describe a major social problem of great concern to you. Discuss key factors that you believe must be addressed in an effort to alleviate the problem; as well as opportunities and challenges likely to surface in seeking a solution. You may cite references. (2 pages)
3. If there is anything else you would like us to know as we consider your academic or work history, please describe. Include any honors, awards, scholarships (optional, maximum 1 page)
