

Post 9/11 GI Bill, Chapter 33 – Statement of Understanding

I _____ understand that my election of Post 9/11 GI Bill, Chapter 33, education benefits is irrevocable and may not be changed.

Once I receive my Certificate of Eligibility from the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs, I _____ will submit a copy to the APSU's Office of Veterans Affairs.

I _____ acknowledge that the APSU's Office of Veterans Affairs can only certify one term at a time and can only certify your enrollment to the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs after the University post actual charges of tuition and fees upon your account.

I _____ understand that if I make any course adjustments to my enrollment that I have to notify the APSU's Office of Veterans Affairs in writing within 2 (two) business days. I acknowledge that this can impact my Post 9/11 GI Bill, Chapter 33, education benefits.

I _____ understand that if I do not complete all my courses or receive a punitive grade that I may be charged an overpayment by the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs. The overpayment may include tuition, fees, monthly housing allowance, and book and supply stipend. The U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs determines the amount of the overpayment, not the school. If I have an existing overpayment with VA, my future benefit payments (including tuition and fees) may be withheld by VA until my overpayment is repaid in full.

I _____ understand that the APmail is the official APSU electronic correspondence method. The APSU's Office of Veterans Affairs will utilize APmail as the official method of communication regarding reminders, paperwork, enrollment certification, courses, etc. It will be my responsibility to check my APmail account.
