
### WHAT IS THE QEP?

- ✓ COMPLIANCE: A SACSCOC requirement for reaffirmation of accreditation
- ✓ STUDENT SUCCESS INTERVENTION: Carefully designed collaborative institutional action research project focused on improving student learning

 CONTEXT AND MISSION: Data driven, developed by us for our students, and aligned with our mission and vision

#### SACSCOC Principles of Accreditation - Standard 7.2

#### **QEP DEVELOPMENT PROCESS TO DATE**

✤Fall 2021- Creation of the QEP Topic Selection Committee

Late Fall 2021 / Early Spring 2022- Call for proposals and sessions that detailed proposals submission requirements

April 2022 – QEP Topic Selection Committee recommended combining elements of two similar proposals

April 2022 – A smaller group of key members formed a revision and planning group that worked on bringing the two proposals together

✤Fall 2022– Met faculty in colleges and departments for feedback; development of pilot

Spring/ Fall 2023 - Further QEP planning, development, and piloting

#### QEP's Focus – Written Communication

*Improve the following student learning written communication outcomes:* 

- The writer presents a clear thesis and focus that is consistent throughout the work.
- The writer fully develops ideas using support appropriate to the genre and/or purpose for writing such as research, sources, information literacy, personal experience, analysis, or observation
- · Clearly orders and consistently connects ideas throughout the work




## QEP's Focus – Self-regulation and Metacognition

Self-regulating and metacognition goals to support SLOs:

- Students are effective in managing their time
- Students are able and willing to seek help they need to be successful.
- Students have a strong sense of locus of control.




### The Focus of the QEP



- Focus on written communication and selfregulation / metacognition skills in QEP courses
- Collaborate with CAFÉ to develop Faculty Learning Communities
- Identify and share effective evidence-base teaching and assessment practices
- Leverage resources i.e., Writing Center, Learning Resource Center, library, etc.
- Develop institution-wide initiatives that support, showcase, and highlight student writing

#### The Focus of the QEP



#### **Embedded Tutors**

Writing Center tutors support faculty and students in and out of the class which may include but not limited to:

- being a liaison between the student and university support services like the Writing Center, Learning Resource Center, etc.
- leading in-class activities and/or create video learning objects for D2L
- supporting and helping facilitate in-class writing activities
- developing and drafting worksheets, materials, notes, etc., taken from lectures, activities
- communicating with students via D2L or other means reminder of due dates
- Collating and making available WC and other writing resources, etc., relevant to the writing assignments
- conducting office hour providing limited support


## Quality Enhancement Plan

#### **Learning Communities**

Learning communities may support faculty and students that include but not limited to:

- reflecting on a significant writing assignment identifying what works well and what could be revised
- identifying pedagogical and assessment approaches and tools to writing that are discipline specific intended to improve student writing and self-regulation outcomes
- sharing and supporting colleagues within the learning community

Development of "fun" and engaging campus-wide events that support, highlight, and showcase good writing which may include journal of student writing, writing contest, etc.




