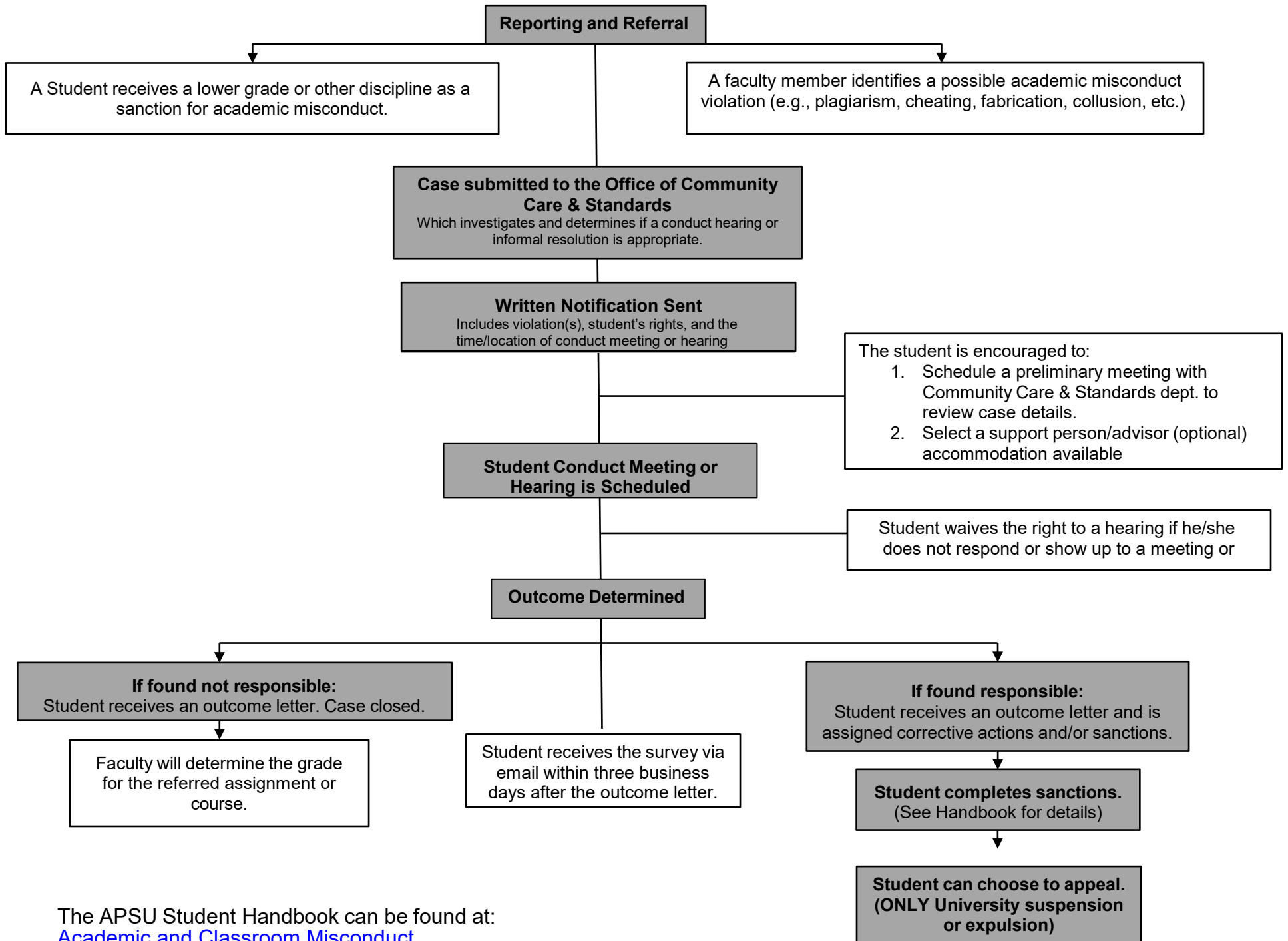

APSU Student Social Norms (TN Together Survey, 2024)

Positive Social Norms Without Alcohol

64% of APSU Students report that parties and social events are just as enjoyable without alcohol.

Students Prefer Drug-Free Environments

78.4% of students believe social events are not made more enjoyable by the presence of drugs.

Students Intentionally Avoid High-Risk Environments

Over half of APSU students (51.%) consciously avoid places where excessive drinking occurs.

Responsible Drinking Habits

Among those who drink, most APSU students consume only about three drinks per occasion, demonstrating moderation.

Healthy Campus Culture

A substantial majority – 90% of students – do not feel that the APSU environment promotes alcohol use.

No Intention to Get Drunk

80% of APSU students say they did not intend to get drunk the last time they drank.

Community Accountability

75% of APSU Students are asked to show ID when purchasing alcohol near campus – reinforcing legal compliance and safety.

Common Consequences are Mild

The most reported outcomes of drinking are manageable and typically include hangovers, nausea, or forgetfulness.
