General Information

Manufacturing Technology Institute (MTI) Summer Camp at APSU June 7, 2020 - June 26, 2020

The MTI Summer Camp is a grant funded, free camp at Austin Peay State University providing a unique opportunity for currently sophomore and junior high school students to gain dual enrollment credit in the Career and Technical Education (CTE) area. The purpose of the camp is to educate students in the industrial manufacturing workforce sector. Qualifying* students will be housed on campus at APSU during the three week summer camp which will consist of daily dual-enrollment lecture and lab sessions in the morning. In the afternoon, students will learn from business professionals about important soft skills for future successful employment. Also, there will be scheduled tours of local industrial manufacturing partners. Overall, the student is being exposed to a "one-stop shop" experience that allows him/her to explore different career paths while gaining real-world skills that can lead to a brighter future for the student. Funding for the MTI Summer Camp is provided by the 2019-2020 GIVE grant put forth by Governor Lee, and has a funded life-span of three years.

*Qualifying students must have a minimum 3.0 high school GPA, complete this application and should the student be accepted to the program, you will receive additional documents to complete (e.g., dietary information, immunization records, emergency contacts, and etc.).

Participants in the MTI summer camp are not required to be dual enrolled. However, if your student wants to have college credit then please check eligibility and apply to receive tuition assistance through TN Dual Enrollment Grant using the below link.
