a non-refundable \$180 deposit. You will also need to upload the Academic Advisor Approval form in
this process.
Once you are accepted into the program, you can make an appointment to meet with the study abroad
office if you still have questions or concerns, though mandatory advising is not required.

so the early you apply, the better!)

Once you have your passport and the dates for the trip are finalized, register your trip with the U.S.
Department of State through their Smart Traveler Enrollment Program (<u>STEP</u>).
Attend pre-departure orientation on study day- December 4 th at 10:00 am. Register for this orientation
<u>here</u> .
Full payment due on December 15 th .
There will be a commitment step once you are accepted into the program through the application
process. This step will include submitting your passport information to the study abroad office before
departure.
