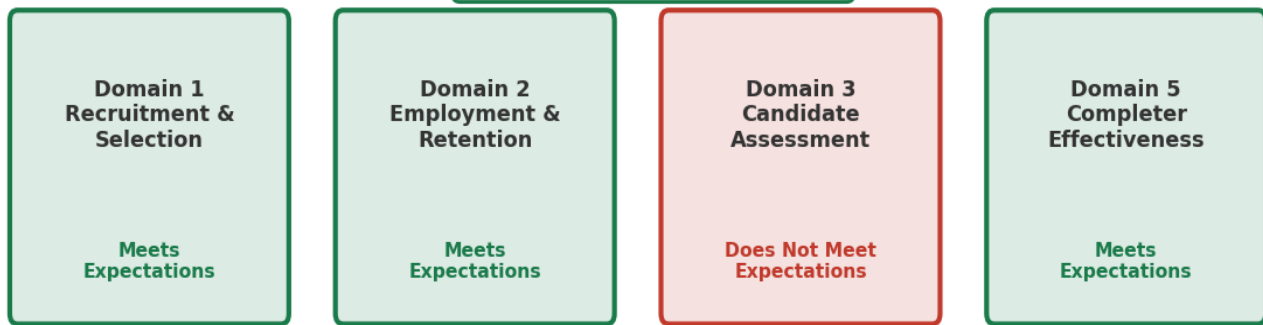

An EPP must meet two of three metrics, or meet the TVAAS metric, to meet expectations in Domain 5. APSU met LOE and Observation (two of three), satisfying the domain requirement. Domain 4 (Completer, Partner and Employer Satisfaction) is not currently included in the Performance Report.
