The Candidate Assessment domain evaluates a provider's performance in preparing candidates to pass the literacy and subject-area assessments required to obtain a Tennessee teaching license. This domain includes two scored metrics and one unscored metric.

**Does Not Meet Expectations**

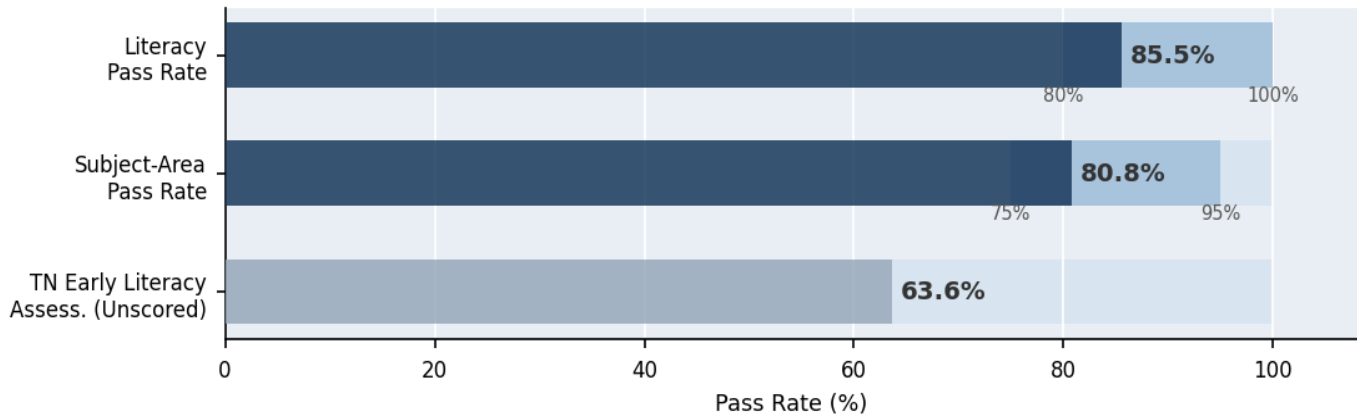
#### Why is this important?

Candidate assessments help ensure that new teachers enter the classroom with the knowledge and skills they need to be successful. EPPs play a key role in preparing candidates for these assessments.

Scoring: "Does Not Meet Expectations" = less than 50% of possible points. "Meets Expectations" = 50-74.9%. "Exceeds Expectations" = 75% or more.

To meet expectations, EPPs must meet the required number of scored metrics within this domain. The Literacy Assessment threshold of 90% pass rate within 2 attempts was not met (APSU: 85.5%). An EPP must meet two of the three metrics to meet expectations. EPPs above the scored range receive maximum points; below, zero points.
