Provider Impact | 2024-2025 Report Card

The Provider Impact domain reports the evaluation scores of a provider's cohort members who are teaching in Tennessee public schools. Teacher evaluation in Tennessee consists of multiple metrics, including classroom observations by trained evaluators and measures of teachers' impact on students' learning.

Meets Expectations

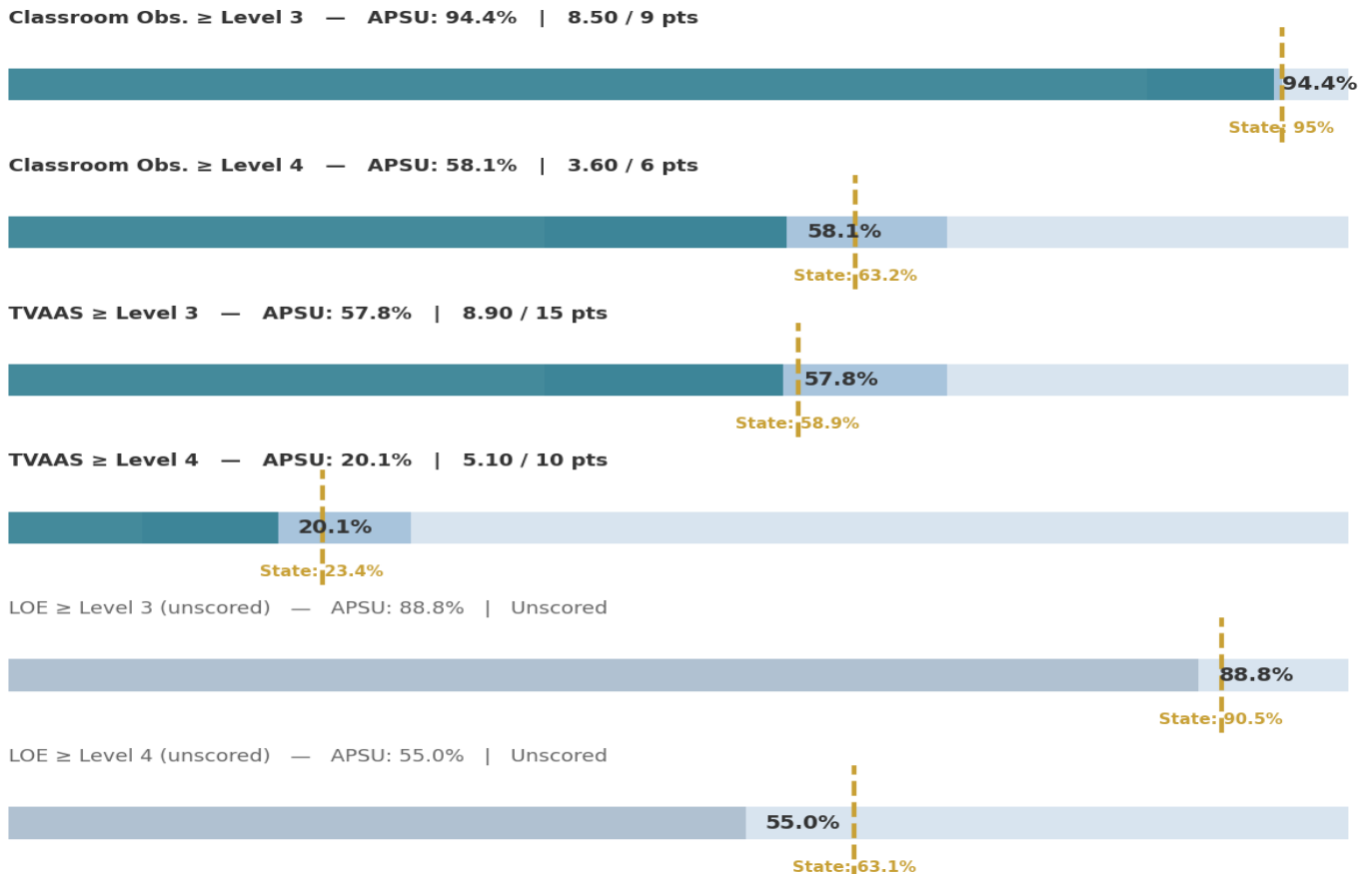
Why is this important?

Teachers are the most important in-school factor contributing to students' success. EPPs that consistently prepare effective teachers contribute directly to positive student outcomes across Tennessee.

Scoring: "Does Not Meet Expectations" = less than 50% of possible points. "Meets Expectations" = 50-74.9%. "Exceeds Expectations" = 75% or more. EPPs above the scored range receive maximum points; below, zero points.
