The Satisfaction domain reports how well cohort members feel that their preparation program prepared them for teaching. Data for this domain come from the annual Tennessee Educator Survey. This domain includes three unscored metrics; no performance rating is calculated from these results.

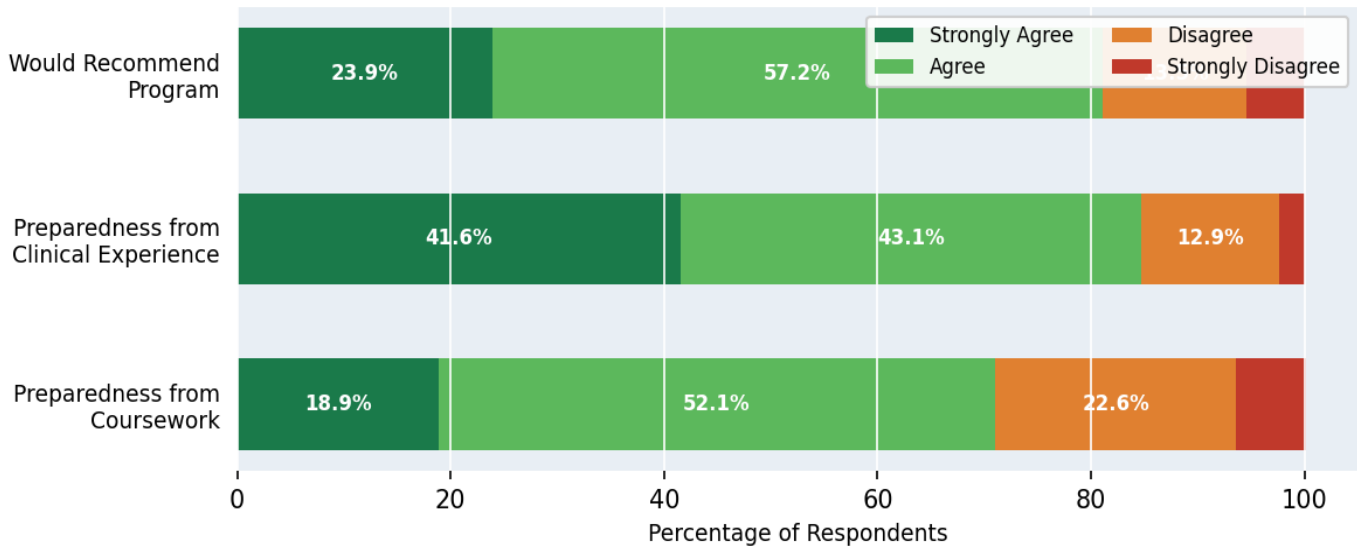
About This Domain

Completer Survey Results

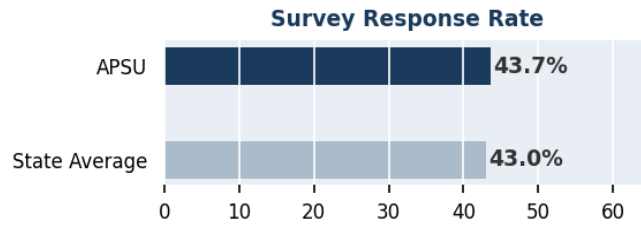
The chart below shows the distribution of responses across three survey items. Respondents are recent APSU initial program completers employed in Tennessee public schools at the time of the survey (N=225, response rate: 43.7%).

Survey data come from the Tennessee Educator Survey administered annually to educators employed in Tennessee public schools. APSU's response rate of 43.7% slightly exceeds the state average of 43.0% (N=225 respondents).
