I. Call to order

II. Approval of Minutes

Gary Stewart made the motion to accept the minutes. Barbara Peterson seconded, and the motion carried with corrections to the Mathematics Proposal.

IV. Dr. McConnell's Position

John McConnell has been appointed as Associate Dean to the College of Education.

V. Program Reviews

VI. edTPA Committee Proposal

Lisa Barron brought forth a new proposal for edTPA. New proposed scores of 41 for 15 rubrics and 35 for 13 rubrics (World Languages), as opposed to the current passing score of 40 for 15 rubrics and 35 for 13 rubrics. In addition, beginning Fall 2017 everyone will have to have a score of 42 (36 for 13 rubrics) per state policy. All retakes beginning Fall 2017 must be submitted to Pearson for national scoring, at the candidates expense. \$100 per task. Beginning January 2017 a passing score on the edTPA will be required instead of the PLT. Gary Stewart made the motion to accept the changes. Linda Davis seconded, and the motion carried.

VII. Praxis Changes

The State Board of Education plans to significantly increase the required scores for all PRAXIS II. Each area should provide help sessions for students. Funding for faculty to provide workshops is available.
