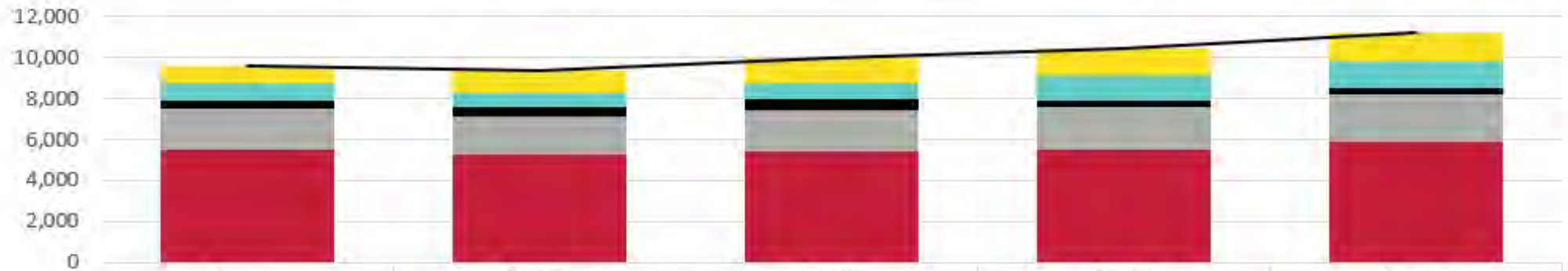

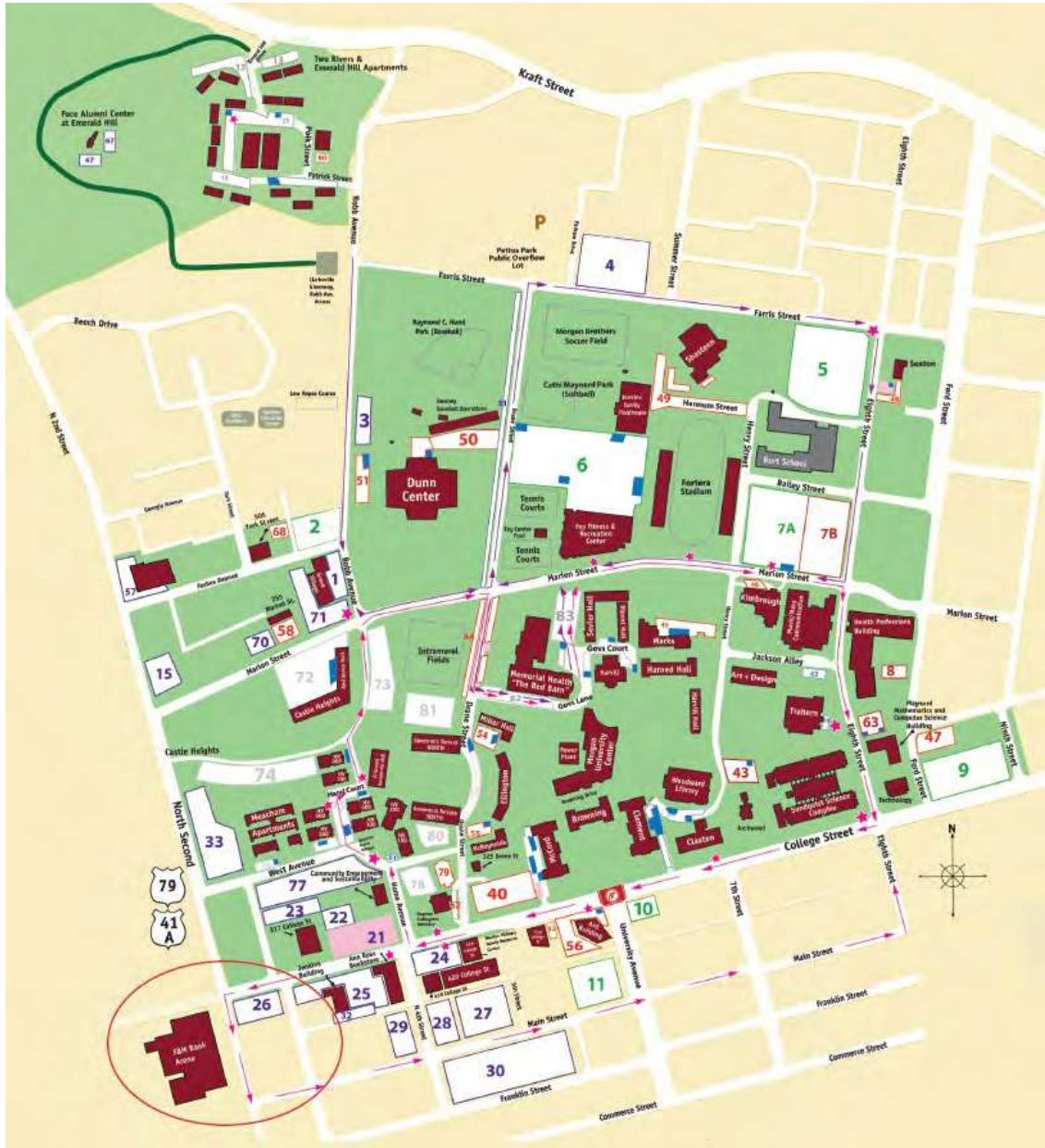

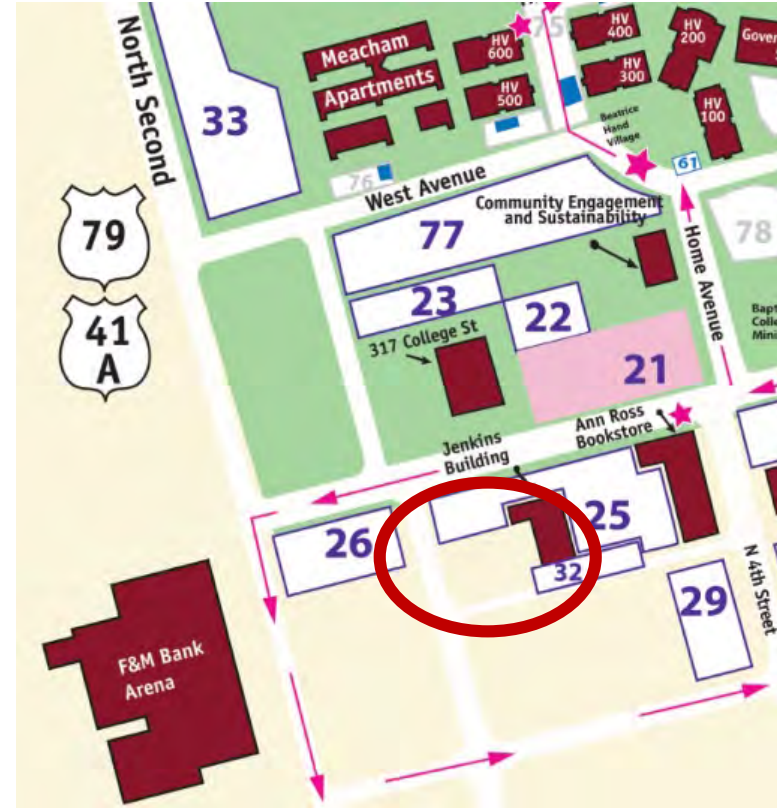
CONSIDERATION OF LOT 26 LAND LEASE

Consideration of the Lot 26 Land Lease

- 45-year ground lease agreement with Urban Six Realty for the development of a mixed-use project on Lot 26, located at the corner of College Street and Second Street.
- Urban Six Realty will design, construct, operate, and manage a privately funded development consisting of retail and residential space.
- APSU will receive \$50,000 per year for the land lease.
- The project aligns with APSU's strategic goals related to public-private partnerships and auxiliary revenue generation.
- Will also require approval by the State Building Commission and other appropriate governmental authorities.

Consideration of Community Engagement & Sustainability Center Renovation

- Presented to the Board as an information item on March 22, 2024.
- The total project cost is not to exceed \$1.2 Million
 - The donor will cover all costs other than furnishings
 - APSU will cover the cost of furnishings, not expected to exceed \$200K
- Renovation of the bookstore annex garage space to develop a new Community Engagement and Sustainability Center to host the best-in-state campus food pantry program and center.
