

## Guide to Bylaw Changes

### Document improvements

1. Page 1 Section B Line 42-43; 45-46; 49-50
  - a. Clarifies reports can be submitted in written or electronic form
2. Page 3 Section A Line 114-115
  - a. Redundant with Section C Line 121
3. Page 3 Section B Line 117-119
  - a. Grammar changes
  - b. Insert “and the Provost’s Council” to reflect reinstated committee
4. Page 4 Article V Section A 2. Bullet 153-157
  - a. Created a new bullet to separate for clarity
  - b. Clarification of responsibilities and correct procedure for officers.
5. Page 6 Article VI Section A Line 277-279
  - a. Clarifies reports can be submitted in written or electronic form
6. Page 8 Required date changes if approved by Faculty Senate Line 342

### Changes of a substantial nature

1. Page 3 Article IV Section C Line 121-123
  - a. “Nominations for the office of President will only be accepted in the case that the current Vice President is unwilling to serve as President in the upcoming year.”
2. Page 4 Article V Section A Line 144-147
  - a. “The Faculty Senate Vice President shall serve a one-year term and will automatically become the next Faculty Senate President. In the event that the Vice President chooses not to succeed the President, an election for both President and Vice President will follow Article IV Procedures for the Election of Senate Officers.”
3. Page 4 Section C Line 188
  - a. Academic committees shall consist of no more than “Seven (7)” members changing from Five (5) members
