

Graduate Assistant – Communication
20-Hour Per Week Graduate Assistantship
Position Classification: Graduate Teaching Assistant (GTA)

General Description

The Department of Communication offers several graduate teaching assistantships each year. These positions are awarded on a case-by-case basis, and contingent upon applicants' academic credentials and the Department of Communication's needs.

Primary Duties and Responsibilities

Graduate Teaching Assistants in the Department of Communication work closely with supervising faculty to teach classes, supervise undergraduate students, assist with a variety of radio, television, and live productions and complete other duties as assigned by the faculty supervisor, department chair, or graduate coordinator.

Essential Functions

Teach one or two classes each semester and/or participate in other activities as assigned by the faculty supervisor, department chair, or graduate coordinator, not to exceed 20 hours total per week.

Qualifications

Applicants must be admitted to the Department of Communication's MA program (or a closely related graduate program).
