

M.S. Management - Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

What is the cost of the program?	What is the technology requirement for the program?
Our courses are charged per credit hour. For our current tuition prices, visit https://www.apsu.edu/student-account-services/tuition_and_fees/index.php .	Students are expected to have access to a PC or laptop, reliable internet access, and Microsoft Office in order to be successful in the program. Always review your course syllabus for course specific requirements.
How long will it take for me to complete this program?	If I have taken graduate courses at another institution, can I transfer those credits?
The M.S. in Management can be completed in as little as one year depending on when you start. If a student wishes to extend their program, they are welcome to do so but since certain classes are only offered in specific terms, it is best to plan your degree completion plan with an advisor.	Students may transfer up to six hours of approved coursework from an AACSB-accredited institution. The graduate coordinator or appropriate faculty member of the graduate program will evaluate the course(s) being proposed for transfer to determine suitability. No course with a grade below a "B" will be considered for transfer. Transfer of credit should be completed by the end of the student's first term
What should I do if I am using VA benefits or tuition assistance through an employer?	I'm active duty military. What happens if I get called away and cannot complete a term?
Many students utilize VA benefits or tuition assistance/reimbursement programs through their employers. Students are encouraged to consult with the Office of Student Financial Aid.	Austin Peay prides itself on being a military-friendly university. If you are unable to complete a semester due to military service, please contact your professor and the Director of Graduate Programs. It is likely that you will receive an "incomplete" and work with the professor to finish the coursework within a year.
What happens if I move?	Is there a deadline to apply for the program?
The program is online, so it can be completed at any location that has reliable internet access. If you are utilizing scholarships or other types of financial aid that require residency, you are encouraged to contact the Office of Student Financial Aid to see if moving will impact your award/tuition.	It is recommended that you apply for the program at least a month before the start date in order to have time to submit all documents needed, be accepted/denied, and if accepted, register for courses after consulting with an advisor.
Do I have to take an admissions exam (e.g., GMAT, GRE)?	What materials do I need in order to apply?
Students who have the GPA to be waived from the GMAT will not have to take the entrance exam. If you do not meet this requirement, you will need to take the GMAT exam, which can be scheduled by going to www.mba.com . Do I have to have a background in business?	How many credit hours is the program?
No, you do not have to have a background in business, but if your undergraduate degree is not in business, you will need to take Business Foundations (MGT 5010) in your first semester. This course will count as one of your four electives.	The program is 30 credit hours and consists of 18 hours of core coursework and 12 elective courses.
Will I have to go to the Ft. Campbell base since the program is through Ft. Campbell?	
No, the program is online and you are not expected to come to Ft. Campbell or the Clarksville campus.	
Are there any other expenses in addition to tuition?	
Students are expected to pay for materials needed for each class, such as books or modules. For example, if you are required to take MGT 5010, you will be required to purchase Ivy Software modules for successful completion of the course.
