

Prerequisite Foundational Coursework Requirements

Applicants whose undergraduate degree is not in Communication Sciences and Disorders will be reviewed to determine which prerequisite course work has been completed. Courses completed in the last six years in which the student earned a “C” or better will fulfill this requirement.

Transcripts must show evidence of the applicant’s acquisition of knowledge associated with CFCC 2020 Standard IV-A: *The applicant must have demonstrated knowledge of statistics as well as the biological, physical, and social/behavioral sciences.*

Transcripts must show evidence of the applicant’s knowledge associated with CFCC 2020 Standard IV-B *The applicant must have demonstrated knowledge of basic human communication and swallowing processes, including the appropriate biological, neurological, acoustic, psychological, developmental, and linguistic and cultural bases. The applicant must have demonstrated the ability to integrate information pertaining to normal and abnormal human development across the life span.*

Transcripts should show evidence of an equivalent course to the APSU course; applicants may be asked to provide syllabi if there is a question		SCH
