FACULTY-ASSESSMENT RUBRIC FOR MASTER OF SPEECH-LANGUAGE PATHOLOGY (MSLP) MISSION, VISION, GOALS AND STRATEGIC PLAN

Full-time faculty will be required to participate in the following process designed to evaluate the program mission, vision, goals and strategic plan. The evaluation process will be an annual process that occurs at a final program meeting that should occur no later than the second week in June at the end of each academic year (1.5.7. revision from application). Evaluation of the MSLP Program Mission, Vision, Goals and Strategic Plan is important as results will provide direction for effective delivery of the clinical education program, inform operational logistics, and determine resource identification and allocation. The evaluation process will also inform plans for improvement that will ensure program success and sustainability.

The process:

- 1) MSLP program faculty will evaluate progress toward program goals by updating strategic plan progress (1.5.7).
- 2) MSLP program faculty will evaluate the congruence of the program mission and goals with the university (1.4.2)
- 3) MSLP faculty will measure progress toward fulfilling the MSLP mission using multiple sources of data (1.4.3).
- 4) MSLP program faculty will evaluate congruence of the program's strategic plan with the mission and goals of the program (1.5.4).
- 5) MSLP program faculty will author an annual summary update of the strategic plan that will be posted to the MSLP web page before the first day of the following term (1.5.7).
