



U.S. BANK FOCUS CARD™ USAGE GUIDE

Make Purchases¹

Your Focus Card can be used wherever Visa®/MasterCard® debit cards are accepted. There is no cost to make domestic purchases in stores, over the phone or online.

- Know your available balance.
- Select **“CREDIT”** on the authorization machine.
- Or select **“DEBIT”** and enter your PIN.

Get Cash²

ATM

- Enter PIN.
- Select **“WITHDRAWAL”** from **“CHECKING”**.

BANK OR CREDIT UNION TELLER

- Know your balance (the teller will not have access to this information).
- Ask for the amount you wish to withdraw (you can't go over your balance).
- You may need to provide your ID.

CASH BACK

You can ask for “cash back” when you make purchases at places like the grocery store or retail store.

- Select **“DEBIT”** on the authorization machine.
- Enter your 4-digit PIN.
- Select **“YES”** for cash back.
- Enter the amount, press **“OK”**.

Pay Bills

You can visit your billers' websites and provide your 16-digit card number and expiration date.

TEXT/EMAIL³

- Sign up to receive email or text alerts when funds have been deposited to your account or when your balance gets low.

- Perform a balance inquiry at an ATM.
