### **How to apply:**

1. Go to [www.apsu.edu/msc](http://www.apsu.edu/msc)
2. Scroll down and locate the tab “Text for Vets” on the left-hand side of the page and click to open to read our guidelines and stipulations regarding the program; please do this before submitting an application.
3. Click on the tab “Text for Vets Book list” to see the most current up to date list of books listed within our inventory; please do this prior to submitting an application.
4. Click on the tab “Text for Vets Application” to apply for textbooks listed in our inventory; it will ask you affirm your responsibility to follow the rules for utilizing the program, as well as having sections to fill-in the info we need to process the request. Please complete an application for each textbook requested. Please allow 2-3 business days for us to process requests.

### **How to pick up/drop off:**
